Many thanks for your greeting, which was on my desk when I returned from a trip this morning. It was nice to hear from you, but I was sorry to have missed you.

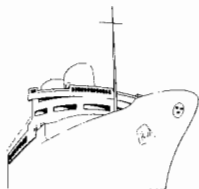

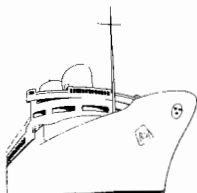
It is too bad that you will not be joining the GRIPSHOLM, but I hope that you will be sailing with us once again before too long.
